

Edmondston-Alston House



In 1825 the Edmondston-Alston House was the first house built on Charleston's High Battery and has since been host to some of history's most influential people. Family possessions remain in place as they have for over 160 years. Tour Charleston's only house museum with harbor views and stand on its piazza as General P.G.T. Beauregard did to watch the 1861 bombing of Ft. Sumter.
